DX NEWS

With the approaching usual summer doldrums combining with the steadily declining sunspot activity, DX conditions have become both sporadic and erratic. Openings to Europe on any band have become a rarity. Conditions to No. and So. Africa somewhat better than to Europe. Propagation to Caribbean, Central and So. American areas has been fair with openings noted on 10, 15, and 20 from late morning until late afternoon. Also at night on 20, and less often even on 40. Conditions also fair to Oceania and Asia beginning in late afternoon on 10 and 15 and ending at night on 20. In the early mornings, fair conditions to Asia and So. Africa (long path) on 20. Interesting DX heard or worked since mid April: On 15-- CE1FF at 0800, 5A8DJ at 1800; on 20-- I5TUF at 0600, VS6AE at 0600, DUSPEP at 0700.
